Palm Sunday



“Truly, this was God’s Son.”

While labeled Sunday School, please feel free to use these ideas in a way that blesses your family. You do not have to do all the activities nor do you need to do them on Sunday morning. You can use whatever translation of the Bible or Children’s Bible you have in your home.

Read: Mark 15: 33-(39)47

Activities and Background:

Remember that very young children do not understand the permanency of death, so they expect Jesus to come alive again. The miracle and power of God over death will be realized when death is understood. What young children do focus upon is that people were hurting Jesus and that Jesus suffered on the cross. As this story is shared with children one must be sensitive to their possible reactions.

1. Read the scripture and wonder about the story with your child. Discuss the emotions one feels as the story is read.
2. Gather stones and pebbles. What can you build from them? Wonder how the big stone placed in front of Jesus’ tomb is moved.
3. Wonder how the Roman soldier knew Jesus was God’s Son. How do you know that Jesus is God’s Son?
4. Read the story one more time and then draw a picture to help you remember the story.
5. Sing “Jesus Loves Me”.
6. End with a prayer.
