## Sunday, April 4, 2021

### Easter Sunday



“Jesus is alive.”

**While labeled Sunday School, please feel free to use these ideas in a way that blesses your family. You do not have to do all the activities, nor do you need to do them on Sunday morning. You can use whatever translation of the Bible or Children’s Bible you have in your home.**

**Read:** John 20:1-18

#### **Activities and Background:**

Jesus’ resurrection is celebrated every Sunday – The Lord’s Day. While we think of Jesus’ resurrection on Easter Sunday, every Sunday is a celebration as we remember “Jesus is alive”. As a family think about how you set Sunday aside to celebrate this.

1. Read the scripture and wonder about the story with your child. Discuss the emotions one feels as the story is read.
2. Talk about family Easter traditions. Why do you celebrate Easter the way you do? What traditions do you have?
3. Mary left the tomb and told the others that Jesus had risen. Pick someone and tell them that Jesus lives. You can call on the phone, email, text or tell them in person.
4. Get some playdoh out and make an empty tomb.
5. Practice saying, “Christ is Risen!” and responding, “Alleluia!”
6. Read the story one more time and then draw a picture to help you remember the story.
7. End with a prayer.
