## Sunday, May 2, 2021

### Fifth Sunday of Easter



*“Little girl, get up.”*

While labeled Sunday School, please feel free to use these ideas in a way that blesses your family. You do not have to do all the activities, nor do you need to do them on Sunday morning. You can use whatever translation of the Bible or Children’s Bible you have in your home.

**Read:** Mark 5: 21-24, 35-43

#### **Activities and Background:**

1. Read the scripture and wonder about the story with your child. How do you think the people in the story felt?
2. Have you ever been sick? Who are the people who helped you get better? How did they help you feel better?
3. Gather and have a meal and give thanks for health.
4. Pray for someone who is sick.
5. Make cards for people who are on your church’s prayer list.
6. Act out the story as it is retold.
7. Have you ever been in a crowd and could not move quickly? Were you late for something?
8. Read the story one more time and then draw a picture to help you remember the story.
9. End with a prayer.
