## Sunday, May 30, 2021

### First Sunday After Pentecost



While labeled Sunday School, please feel free to use these ideas in a way that blesses your family. You do not have to do all the activities, nor do you need to do them on Sunday morning. You can use whatever translation of the Bible or Children's Bible you have in your home.

**Read:** Acts 2: 37-47

#### **Activities and Background:**

This was culturally a new concept and made the early Christians stand out as they shared equally and took care of even the vulnerable in their midst.

1. Read the scripture and wonder about the story with your child. I wonder what it means to share everything.
2. Are there things we should share and things we should not share? It is Ok to share your crayons but maybe not your toothbrush. But you could give someone a new toothbrush. Make a list of things you can share and things you should not share. Then figure out ways to give safely those things you should not share.
3. Read the story one more time and then draw a picture to help you remember the story.
4. Decide as a family how you will share something with someone else. Open your home to an exchange student. Give clothes or toys to a homeless shelter.
5. Is there anything that others have shared with you?
6. End with a prayer.
