

**Sunday School Lesson**  
**Sunday, June 27, 2021**  
**Fifth Sunday After Pentecost**



“Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind and Love your neighbor as you love yourself.”

While labeled Sunday School, please feel free to use these ideas in a way that blesses your family. You do not have to do all the activities, nor do you need to do them on Sunday morning. You can use whatever translation of the Bible or Children’s Bible you have in your home.

**Read:** Luke 10:25-37

**Activities and Background:**

Here we have the parable of the Good Samaritan.

1. Read the scripture and wonder about the story with your child. I wonder how the man on the road felt when others walked by. How would you feel? How did he feel when the Samaritan approached him to help? (Remember in those days these two groups of people did not get along.)
2. Name your neighbors who live near to you. Name neighbors who live far away from you. Name neighbors who are very much like you and name neighbors who are not so much like you.
3. Decide as a family some ways to help a neighbor who lives close to you (rake leaves, give a cake, shovel snow, cut grass, visit). Offer to do that for a neighbor. Decide as a family some way to help neighbors who live far from you (give to a food pantry, make a flood bucket for CWS, visit [cwsglobal.org](http://cwsglobal.org) for more ideas).
4. Read the story one more time and then draw a picture to help you remember the story.
5. End with a prayer.
